Biodiversity Policy

1. Logan Group Company Limited will consider biodiversity factors appropriately during the course of its daily operations.
2. In line with the Biodiversity Policy, the Company will:
 - 1) encourage itself to conduct biodiversity assessments related to the selection of sites for new development projects, and to use natural resources that are important to biodiversity;
 - 2) raise the awareness of its employees and suppliers as well as the people who have business dealings with the Company about biodiversity;
 - 3) facilitate the restoration of the ecosystem within the scope that has a major impact on its business operations;
 - 4) support appropriate biodiversity and conservation programs;
 - 5) minimize the adverse impact of its business operations on biodiversity and the ecosystem.
3. We will review this policy every year.

Letter of Undertaking on Biodiversity

As a developer, owner and operator of integrated projects, Logan Group Company Limited will appropriately consider biodiversity factors in its operations. In line with the Biodiversity Policy, the Company HEREBY UNDERTAKES:

1. to encourage itself to conduct biodiversity assessments related to the selection of sites for new development projects in which the Company has a controlling interest;
2. not to carry out operations/exploration/mining/drilling in World Heritage Sites and IUCN-IV protected areas;
3. to adopt a mitigation hierarchy (avoid, minimize, restore and offset) when carrying out activities in areas with important biodiversity on a global or national basis;
4. to minimize the adverse impact of its business operations on biodiversity and the ecosystem, including the promotion of the sustainable use of natural resources that are important to biodiversity;
5. to support appropriate biodiversity and conservation programs;
6. to raise the awareness of its employees, customers and suppliers as well as the people who have business dealings with the Company

about biodiversity and conservation;

7. to facilitate the restoration of the ecosystem within the scope that has a major impact on its business operations.
